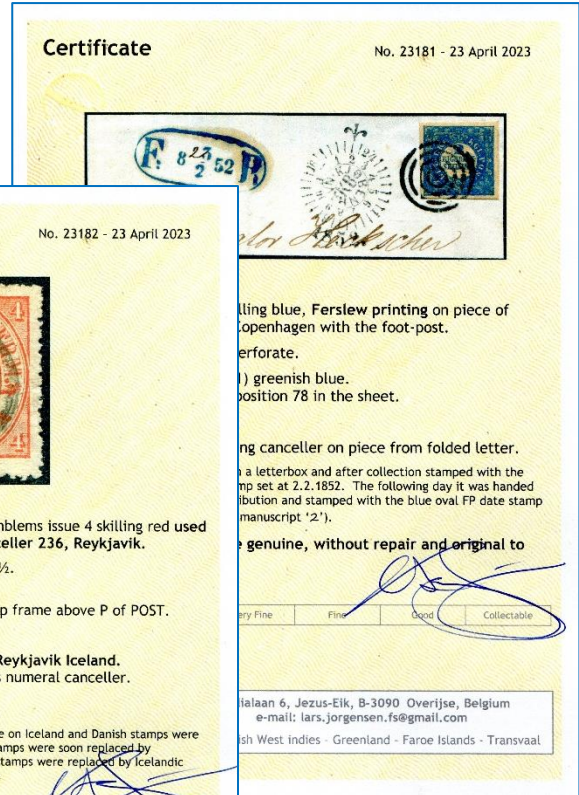
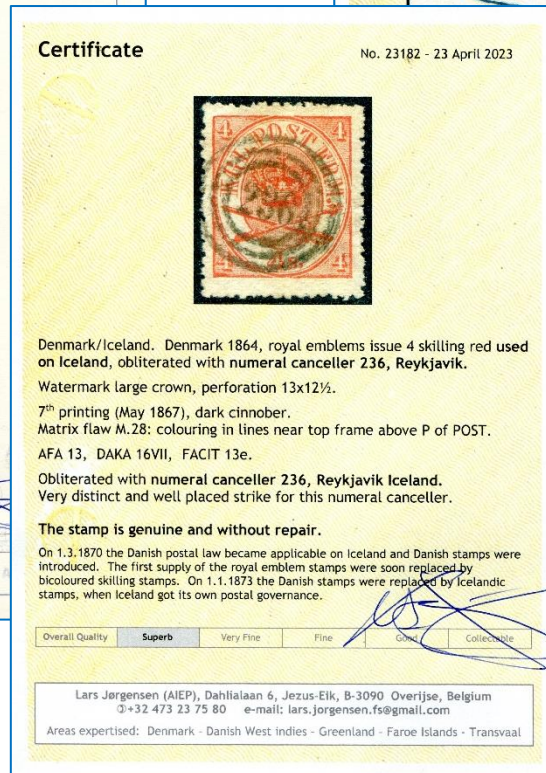


Lars Jørgensen AIEP Stamp Expertising

Certificates are issued for stamps and covers from:

Denmark, Danish West Indies, Greenland, the Faroe Islands, Iceland and Transvaal

Certificates

Based on a thorough examination certificates are issued expressing an expert opinion on authenticity and an overall assessment of condition (quality) including mention of any repairs or hidden faults. Stamps are catalogued (AFA, Facit, DAKA/Michel; for Transvaal: Stanley Gibbons) and where feasible the printing and position will be determined and described. Covers are given a full detailed description of markings, routes and rates. All certificates include a colour image of the object and where relevant enlarged illustrations of details. The certificates are issued in Danish or English as desired and there is a choice between house-format certificates and the AIEP certificate format.

The quality rating of items is based on an overall assessment of the quality considering such factors as colour-freshness, centering, perforation/margins, thins, gum/cancellation and for covers in addition the cleanliness of the cover.

The scale for the overall quality assessment is: Superb - Very Fine - Fine - Good - Collectable.

The work is carried out with the utmost care. If, however, a mistake should occur the cost of the certificate will be refunded. Any possible losses incurred as a consequence of a mistake are not refunded.

Expert Identification

Stamps can also be handed in for an 'expert identification'. An expert identification is a smaller document describing and cataloguing the stamp. For older issues stating from which printing the stamp is and if possible, the position in the sheet. Expert identifications are issued with a colour image of the object.

Handling and Prices

Objects for certification are best send by registered mail and will be returned by registered mail unless something else is agreed. Certificates are normally issued within two weeks of receipt of the objects; allowing for proper examination of the stamps/covers and time for processing the documents.

Material submitted for expertising will be handled diligently and due measures will be taken for safekeeping. But the stamps/covers are examined, stored and posted at senders' risk.
